The Get Qualified Scheme in Malta offers tax credits that allow students to recover up to 70% of their tuition fees after completing their studies. This scheme applies to programmes leading to a qualification recognised by the Malta Qualifications Framework (MQF) at Level 3 or above. Eligible programmes include Certificates, Diplomas, Degrees, and postgraduate qualifications such as Masters and Doctorates. In addition, you are required to live and work in Malta for at least two years after completing your course to remain eligible for the tax credit.

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Master of Public Health (MPH)

The Master of Public Health (MPH) is a demanding and intellectually challenging postgraduate programme designed to equip students with the advanced knowledge, analytical skills, and professional competencies required to address complex and evolving public health challenges. The programme focuses on the study of population health, disease prevention, health systems, and evidence-based interventions at local, national, and global levels.

The programme is delivered through specialised pathways in Epidemiology, Health Promotion, and Leadership and Management, allowing students to tailor their studies to specific areas of public health practice and expertise. Students develop an understanding of key areas such as epidemiology, health research methods, quantitative and qualitative analysis, health promotion strategies, and public health leadership, alongside applied knowledge in their chosen pathway. The programme emphasises critical thinking, data interpretation, research literacy, and the evaluation of health policies and interventions.

Entry requirements

- To be eligible for admission to the Master of Public Health (MPH) programme, applicants should normally possess the equivalent of an MQF Level 6 qualification, typically a relevant Bachelor's degree with a minimum classification of 2:2 or above in Public Health, Biology, Health and Social Care, Psychology, Sociology, or a related discipline. Degrees in Business and Management may also be considered where relevant public health content, research methods, and an empirical project have been completed.
- Applicants who are healthcare professionals holding a relevant MQF Level 6 qualification (e.g., nurses, social workers, social care practitioners, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, midwives, and related professions) will also be considered.
- Applicants who do not meet the standard academic entry requirements may also be considered through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), where relevant professional experience, in-company training, or formal professional development in health-related areas can be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
- Applicants must also demonstrate sufficient English language proficiency to successfully undertake the programme. This is typically evidenced by an overall IELTS score of 6.0 (with a minimum of 5.5 in each component), or an equivalent approved English language qualification.

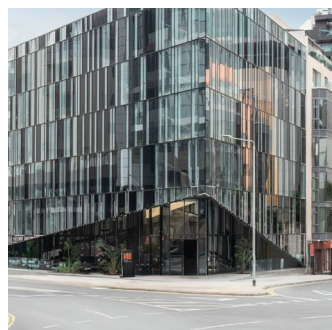

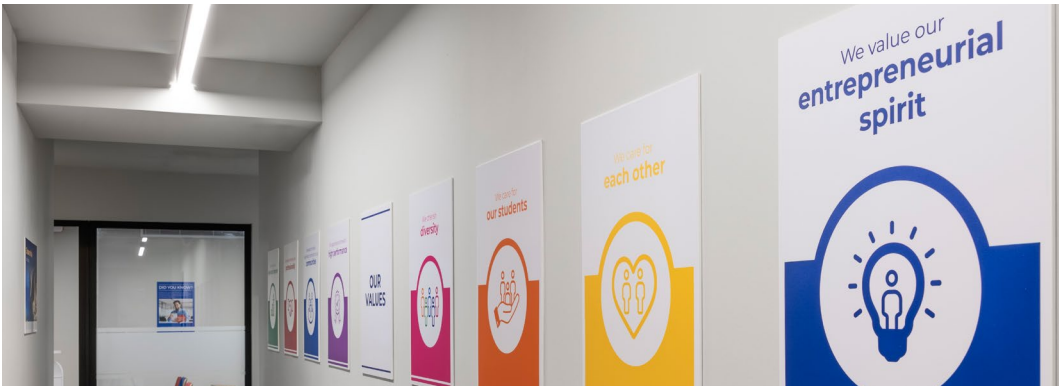
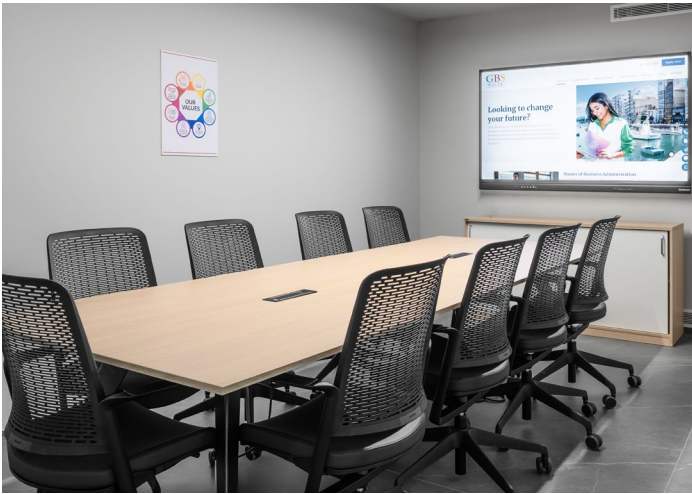
